In response to rapid growth in the Greenville community, Shepherd of the Hills Lutheran Church needed a larger facility. The church decided to demolish part of its facility and replace it with a 22,000 SF addition.

Concrete masonry units manufactured by County Materials provided a resilient and attractive building material that is cost effective to install and maintain. Available in structural concrete load bearing and full and thin veneer units, concrete masonry units can be used in inventive ways to build one-of-a-kind façades, interior walls, and support structures.

Splitface Masonry Units were specified for their unmatched structural strength, speed of construction, and design flexibility. A significant consideration in the decision to use Splitface units was their ability to be custom manufactured to match the color and appearance of the existing masonry. Splitface units are durable and integrally colored to offer lasting color performance that resists weather and wear.

County Materials provided samples as needed to ensure an ideal color match. The custom-colored units were manufactured to meet the construction schedule, utilizing County Materials' enhanced production capacity.

Shepherd of the Hills wanted an uplifting hill design on the largest exterior wall of the expansion. Splitface Masonry Units in Mocha form a gentle curve that represents a hill. The units in a custom color were used inside to build support columns and a decorative fireplace.

County Materials manufactured and delivered 6,000 SF of concrete masonry units and coordinated with the firms on site to ensure timely completion of the project. Church members were pleased with the aesthetic appeal of the expansion and are looking forward to its prolonged service life.
