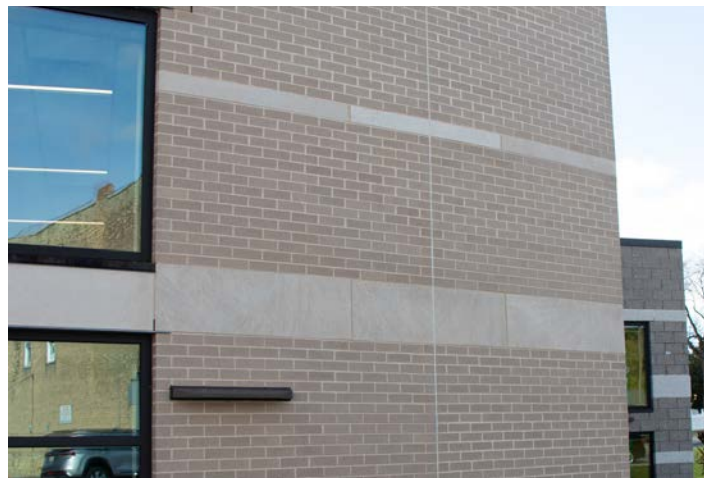
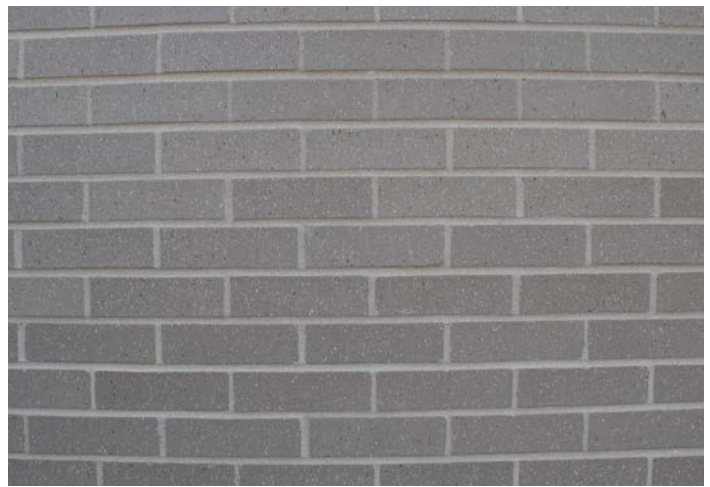
Premier Ultra® Burnished Masonry Units Elevate Historic Library Expansion

Solution: Burnished masonry units and clay brick meet design requirements for the expansion of the historic building.

When the Watertown Public Library was expanded, the builders relied on County Materials to supply burnished masonry units and clay bricks that complement the historical structure.

The installation of 2,700 SF of Premier Ultra Burnished Masonry Units and 4,860 SF of Bowerston Clay Brick took nine months. County Materials coordinated multiple trips to the site with material samples to ensure the product complements the older structure. Clay bricks and concrete masonry units have low life cycle cost due to minimal maintenance requirements and durability.

Premier Ultra Burnished Masonry Units offer the sophisticated character of granite backed by the reliability and competitive pricing of concrete masonry. The units were selected to add contrast and visual interest to the design. Gray clay brick also was installed to seamlessly blend the existing structure and addition.
